

Check your cooling fan motor filter. What type do you have?

Cast-iron cover with canister style filter



Spin-on filter



You may notice two maintenance kits that have the same scheduled service hours for your serial number. The difference is the hydraulic charge filter / cooling fan motor filter.

The hydraulic charge filter or cooling fan motor filter is located under the operator cab. Raise the operator cab and unhook the four rubber straps and remove the lower fan duct. **Identification of this filter is necessary to make sure you receive the correct filter in your maintenance kit.**

The first models in your serial number range were built with a canister filter. The cast-iron cover is removed and the filter inside the canister is replaced. The canister filter is part number: **6692337**.

This is what to look for under the operator cab:

Later models with your serial number range were built with a spin-on cooling fan motor filter. The part number is: **7319444**
